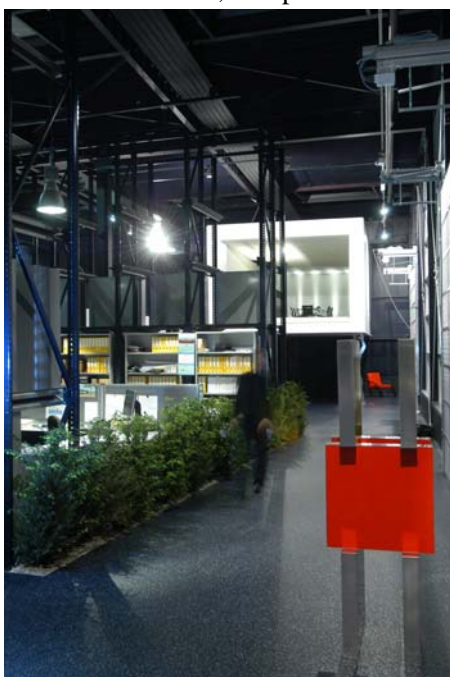


## Industrial character in brand-new premises
