

Bolidt in Italian company

At the Berliner Prachtboulevard one can find the unique office and exhibition building. Römischen Hof, or Roman (court)yard. A jewel for those who love Italian design. This gorgeous protected building is the last large historical building that Vivico has transformed into a modern, representative office and exhibition building with a surface of 9.500 square meters. Because of the artistic atmosphere, Römischen Hof is an exceptional location for representative purposes.

The Construction of Römischen Hof started in 1865 and was taken into use in 1867 as "Hotel de Rome". It was established again in 1910 as an [office building](#) under the name Römischen Hof, in Roman style of course. Monumental pillars and columns decorated the classical main entrance, which inserts itself harmoniously with the legendary and traditional lime trees. So it figures that the Römischen Hof was nominated by a jury for the NIPIM award (prestigious prize related to real estate projects) in the category "modernized office buildings". Out of all international project 15 were nominated in 5 different categories.

Bolidt became part of this Roman yard by applying the Bolidtop® 525 flooring system. On top of the foyer and the whole upper floor, Bolidt also fitted this flooring system in all sanitary spaces as well. The top of the iceberg can be found in the associated [parking garage](#) of the Römischen Hof. A remarkable detail: since Ferrari is one of the tenants, the garage interior is dedicated to the "Ferrari red" colour as a tribute to Ferrari. Of course, the flooring included. Without any problems, Bolidt managed to realise the right unique 'Ferrari red' coloured floor finish.
